You are not separate from your life, and in that life you must find the goodness of God. Otherwise, you will not believe that he has done well by you, and you will not truly be at peace with him. You must find the goodness of God and the fellowship of Jesus in who you are, **OR** your love for the Father and his unique Son cannot become the foundation for a life of abundance and obedience. They (the Father and the Son) desire to dwell with you in your life and make glorious every aspect of it in the light of the whole that God has planned (John 14)." Dallas Willard (DC – pg. 341)
